Every January and February, high school seniors and their parents attend FREE Cash for College workshops for help in filling out the **FAFSA** (Free Application for Federal Student Aid), the application necessary to apply for federal and state financial aid, including Cal Grants. Workshops are hosted at high school sites throughout California.

## Why attend?

- Get FREE, on-the-spot assistance in completing the FAFSA, plus valuable financial aid information, from counseling and financial aid professionals!
- Attend a Cash for College workshop, complete a quick survey, apply for a Cal Grant by the March 2 deadline, and you could qualify for an extra \$1,000 scholarship!
- Non-resident students eligible for in-state tuition assistance under AB 540 may also qualify for the scholarship (AB540 students don't fill out the FAFSA)
- There is something for everyone at Cash for College.

## What to Bring

*If you don't have every one of these documents, that's okay.*

*Come with as many documents that you have and that apply to you.*

- Driver's license
- Social Security card or number for both student and a parent, if available
- Alien registration number, if you are not a U.S. citizen
- Your 2011 income information
- Parent 2011 income information
- Your tax and your parent tax information (2010 tax returns are okay for now, if you don't have 2011 tax information)
- 2011 bank statements
- Any records of untaxed income such as child support payments, payments to retirement accounts, combat pay, short-term disability, or workmen's comp.
- List of colleges you are interested in attending
