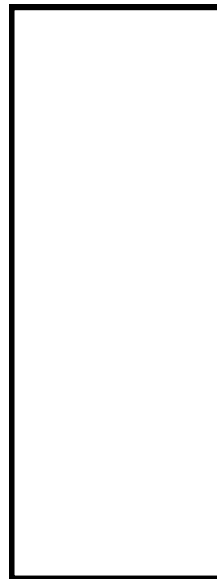

No Cost to the Student

Phoenix Charter Academy is a home school program featuring non-classroom based, independent study, specializing in Personalized Learning. This learning model is recognized and funded by the State of California.

One of PCA's innovative programs is **eSTEAM** (entrepreneurs in Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics). We aim to prep students to meet the rigors of standardized testing and higher education success. These efforts are crucial to raising student achievement, increasing graduation rates and boosting college enrollment. Our **eSTEAM** Program supports these goals enthusiastically by originating experiential learning opportunities both in and outside the classroom to reinvigorate a sense of excitement, wonder, curiosity and inspiration for the investigation and study of (**eSTEAM**) fields. As a NASA Space Place Partner we engaged students through Hands on Labs, Robotics, Engineering, and Project Based Inquiry Learning.



Independent Study-Home School Program Overview

Phoenix Charter Academy is a non-classroom based, with independent study instruction, specializing in personalized learning. We are first and foremost a home school program, but also offer options of once or twice weekly on-site classes. As a public school, there is no cost to the student. The program serves all students from kindergarten through 12th grade, providing academic choices to all students and college preparatory coursework for the college bound students.

Phoenix Charter Academy practices an open enrollment policy, accommodating students of all racial and ethnic backgrounds. No student shall be denied admission based on ethnicity, creed, gender, national origin, socioeconomic profile, or disability.

Our students meet with a Personalized Learning Teacher a minimum of once every 20 school days, or more if needed. If more instruction is needed or desired by the student, tutoring, small CORE class instruction, and academic enrichment classes are available at our school site.

Together, the teacher, student and parent create a curriculum and establish an instructional approach that best complements the student's educational goals and learning style. *All textbooks and/or resources are loaned to the student and MUST be returned at the end of each school year, semester, or as specified in school policy.*

The teacher monitors, reviews, and evaluates the student's work. Samples of student work are submitted along with other required documentation, to the school office, where they are filed in the student's academic records.

Students must maintain a high standard of ethics and quality in their behavior and work. All students must address the standards of Phoenix Charter Academy and the State of California.
